

Our Programs Little Hearts (1–2 Years)

Tiny Little Steps

Our **Little Hearts** program is tailored for toddlers aged 1 to 2 years, a crucial period for growth, exploration and the development of independence. At *Cambridge Montessori Preschool*, we recognize the importance of these formative months in shaping a child's physical, emotional and social development.




Welcoming Spring with Wisdom








Meditation


Brown Day Celebration
